Operating Rules

- Idalia De La Torre, *Field Specialist Supervisor*, reviewed the changes to the Operating Rules.
 - The Operating Rules provides structure to the RCACs and CCI Councils and is a working document that can be changes when necessary.

The following are general changes that were made in the document:

- The RCACs and CCI Councils will now be referred to as the "Consumer Advisory Committees". RCACs and CCIs will still be called the same names.
- The definition of CCI Councils will be included.

Points to Review and Vote:

1. No Dual Membership (must pick RCAC or CCI)

Yes: Unanimous

2. Recertification

Currently, if members lose their L.A. Care membership, they have 60 days to contact DPSS and get their membership back. The recommendation is to shorten it to 30 days. Members voted to keep it at 60 days.

Yes: Unanimous (remain at 60 days) 3. Code of Conduct/Standards of Behavior (60 days to review and sign) Yes: Unanimous 4. Provisional Membership (6 months) **Requirements: New Members must attend the following meetings:** 1) New Member Orientation 2) ECAC or BOG attendance 3) RCAC meetings New members will not receive a stipend until they complete their provisional membership. Childcare and mileage will be reimbursed in the meantime. Comments: Arun Tes Yang mentioned that other organizations provide stipends right after a person becomes a member. VI.	RCAC/Community Work-Plan Group	 2017 RCAC Work Plan Project Kristina Chung provided an update on APLA's project. APLA held its dental event on September 25, 2017 at their offices. 19 people (including 4 RCAC 9 members) were provided dental education and screenings. APLA did not use all of the \$5,000 that was given to them for the project. Therefore, they will plan a dental education workshop on November 29, 2017 at St. Mary Medical Center.
		 2018 RCAC Work Plan Project Idalia De La Torre, Field Specialist Supervisor, provided an update on the 2018 Work Plan Project. The top three HEDIS topics that all the RCACs selected are: Cancer screening Heart Health Diabetes Starting in February 2018, RCAC members will be trained on the 3 topics. After the training is completed, the RCACs will participate in 3 health events to provide outreach to the community. More information will be provided at the December conference.
VII.	FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS	 Cristina Deh-Lee, <i>Chair</i>, asked members if they were having issues with Urgent Care. She shared that the Urgent Care that she went to was not contracted with L.A. Kristina Chung asked members for their thoughts in regards to changing the start time of the meeting from 9:00 am to 10:00 am. Members agreed to change the meeting time to 9:30 am – 12:00 pm.
