

COVERED CALIFORNIA™ OPEN ENROLLMENT HAS ENDED – WHAT'S NEXT?



The Affordable Care Act (ACA) is the single biggest opportunity to increase health coverage in America since the enactment of Medicare and Medicaid in 1965. Millions of people now have new health insurance through the federal and state-run Marketplaces and Medicaid.

L.A. Care Health Plan, the nation's largest publicly operated health plan serving more than 1.3 million members, isn't stopping its efforts to help people get the coverage they need just because Covered California open enrollment is closed until November.
