HEDIS makes it easy for members to compare how health plans perform HEDIS measure the quality that our members receive HEDIS results allow LA Care to identify areas and practices where members may not be getting the care and services as needed To that end, LA. Care has identified the following HEDIS measures as a first step to improving care: Managing diabetes Women's health Francisco Oaxaca, <i>Senior Director of Communications and Community Relations</i>, reported on the following: Health Promoter Program Tanisia Johnson was introduced as the new Health Promoter Program Supervisor. The Health Promoter Program will be going through a restructuring.
