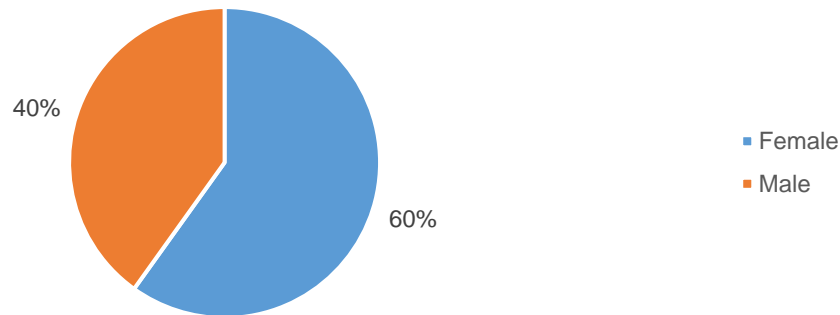


Figure 1. NSMHS utilization by Gender

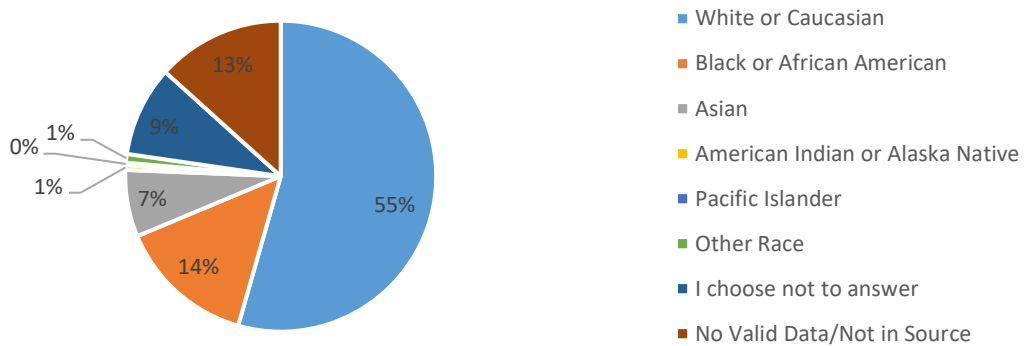


Figure 2. NSMHS utilization by Race

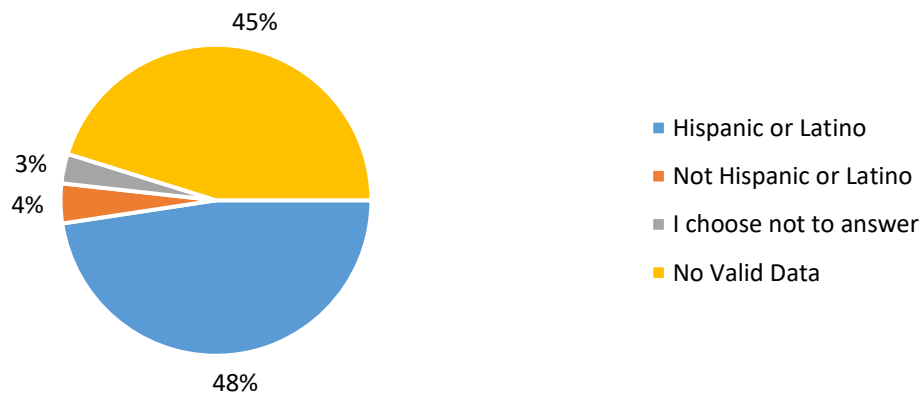


Figure 3. NSMHS utilization by Ethnicity

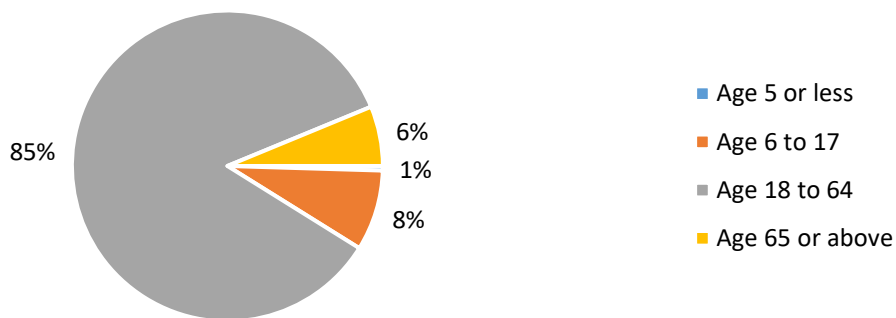


Figure 4. NSMHS utilization by Age Group

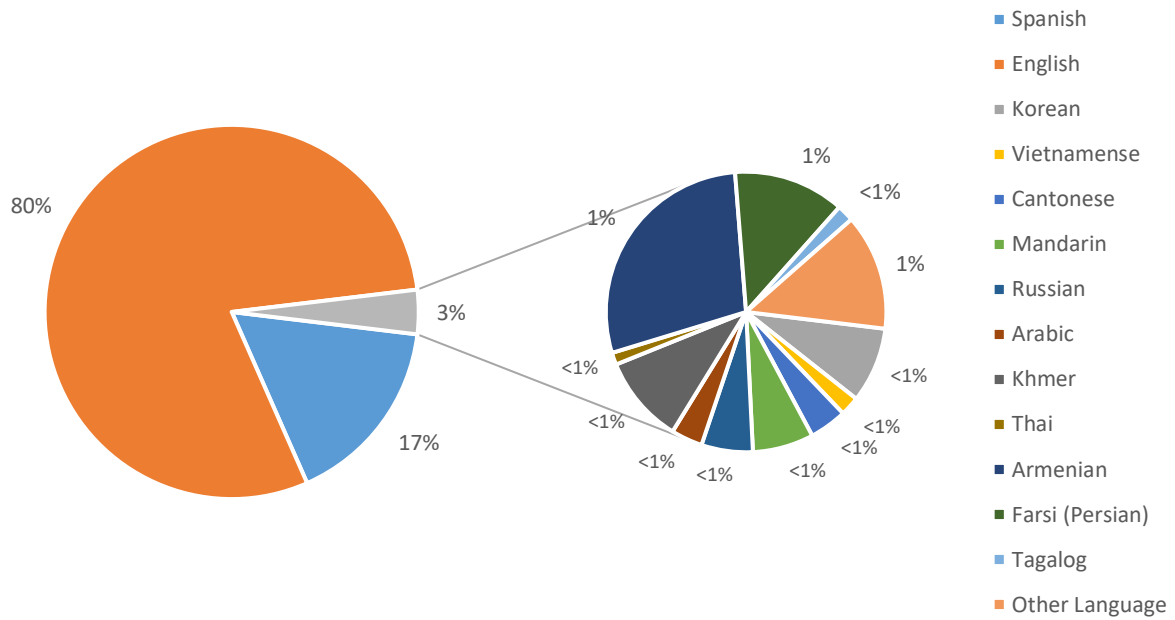


Figure 5. NSMHS utilization by Spoken Language

In Table 5 and Figure 5 Other Language is comprised of those languages for which there were less than ten unique utilizers, these include American Sign Language, Amharic, Bengali, Burmese, Dutch, French, Haitian Creole, Hebrew, Hindi, Igbo, Indonesian, Italian, Japanese, Lao (Laotian), Nepali (Nepalese), Pashto, Portuguese, Punjabi (Panjabi), Romanian, Tigrina (Tigrinya), Ukrainian, Urdu, and those that indicated “Other” when responding to demographic surveys.
